

Pre-Shoot Housekeeping

- Turn on all lights inside AND outside the home
- Open all window treatments so that light can be seen through the windows
- Garden hoses reeled up
- No cars or trash cans in the driveway
- Occupants to depart the property or remain hidden and not visible through windows
- At the end of the shoot, turn off lights, adjust window treatments and securely lock up (if applicable)

TURN ON:

POOL, SPA, ACCENT LIGHTING

GAS FIREPITS (ask for assistance)

Recommended Procedure

- Arrive early, perform pre-shoot housekeeping
- Identify the most attractive angles of property
- Start shooting 15-25 minutes after sunset
- Start with the front yard, recommend 3-4 angles
- Move to backyard, recommend 4-6 angles
- Repeat front yard / backyard rotation 1 time
- Be sure to shoot the same positions on each round
- Don't overshoot, aim for 20 total photos

Recommended Settings

- Make a new folder and reset image count
- File Format: JPG (not RAW), 4000px on long edge
- ISO 100
- Aperture f/8
- Aperture Priority Av
- AEB -3, 0, +3
- Color Profile Neutral
- Evaluative Metering
- Auto White Balance (AWB)
